

WASTE MANAGEMENT

Waste management is the collection, transport, processing or disposal, managing and monitoring of waste materials. The term usually relates to materials produced by human activity, and the process is generally undertaken to reduce their effect on health, the environment or aesthetics. It is a distinct practice from resource recovery which focuses on delaying the rate of consumption of natural resources. All wastes



materials, whether they are solid, liquid, gaseous or radioactive fall within the remit of waste management. It can differ for developed and developing nations, urban and rural areas and residential and industrial producers.

The energy content of waste products can be harnessed directly by using them as a direct combustion fuel, or indirectly by processing them into another type of fuel. Thermal treatment ranges from using waste as a fuel source for cooking or heating and the use of the gas fuel, to fuel for boilers to generate steam and electricity in a turbine.

Pyrolysis and gasification are two related forms of thermal treatment where waste materials are heated to high temperatures with limited oxygen availability. The process usually occurs in a sealed vessel under high pressure. Pyrolysis of solid waste converts the material into solid, liquid and gas products. The liquid and gas can be burnt to produce energy or refined into other chemical products (chemical refinery). The solid residue (char) can be further refined into products such as activated carbon. Gasification and advanced Plasma are gasification are used to convert organic materials directly into a synthetic gas (syngas) composed of carbon monoxide and hydrogen. The gas is then burnt to produce electricity and steam.

Recycling is a resource recovery practice that refers to the collection and reuse of waste materials such as empty beverage containers. The materials from which the items are made can be reprocessed into new products. Material for recycling may be collected separately from general waste using dedicated bins and collection vehicles are sorted directly from mixed waste streams and are known as kerbed-side recycling, it requires the owner of the waste to separate it into various different bins (typically wheelie bins) prior to its collection.

HEALTHY HABITS

Healthy eating is about more than the food on your plate. It is also about how you *think* about food. Healthy eating habits can be learned and it is important to slow down and think about food as nourishment rather than just something to gulp down in between meetings or on the way to pick up the kids. Healthy habits can protect you from the harmful effects of stress.



- Eat with others whenever possible. Eating with other people has numerous social and emotional benefits.
 Eating in front of the TV or computer often leads to mindless overeating.
- Take time to chew your food and enjoy mealtimes.
 Chew your food slowly, savoring every bite and relish.
 We tend to rush though our meals, forgetting to actually taste the flavors and feel the textures of our food.
 Reconnect with the joy of eating.
- Listen to your body. Ask yourself if you are really hungry or have a glass of water to see if you are thirsty instead of hungry. During a meal, stop eating before you feel full. It actually takes a few minutes for your brain to tell your body that it has had enough food, so eat slowly.
- Eat breakfast and eat smaller meals throughout the day. A healthy breakfast can jumpstart your metabolism, and eating small, healthy meals throughout the day (rather than the standard three large meals) keeps your energy up and your metabolism going.
- Avoid eating at night. Try to eat dinner earlier in the day and then fast for 14-16 hours until breakfast in the next morning. After dinner snacks tend to be high in fat and calories so are best avoided, anyway.
- Get enough sleep. Try to get six to eight hours of sleep each night. If you can't sleep, take steps to help reduce stress and depression. Physical activity also may improve the quality of sleep.
- Engage in daily physical activity. Regular physical activity relieves mental and physical stress. Physically active adults have lower risk of depression and loss of mental functioning. Physical activity can be a great source of pleasure, too. Try walking, swimming or dancing every day.

NUMERICAL ANALYSIS AND ITS APPLICATIONS

The overall goal of the field of numerical analysis is the design and analysis to give approximate but accurate solutions to complex problems, the variety of which is suggested by the following.

Advanced numerical methods; Computing the trajectory of a spacecraft; Car companies can improve the crash safety of their vehicles by using computer simulations; Hedge funds (private investment funds); Airlines use sophisticated optimization algorithms, ;Insurance companies use numerical programs for actuarial analysis etc.

Consider the problem of solving

$$3x^3 + 4 = 28$$

Direct method $3x^3 + 4 = 28$. Subtract $4 3x^3 = 24$.
